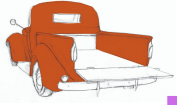

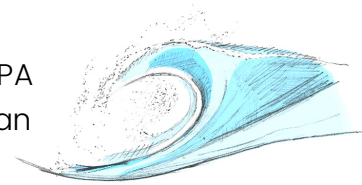

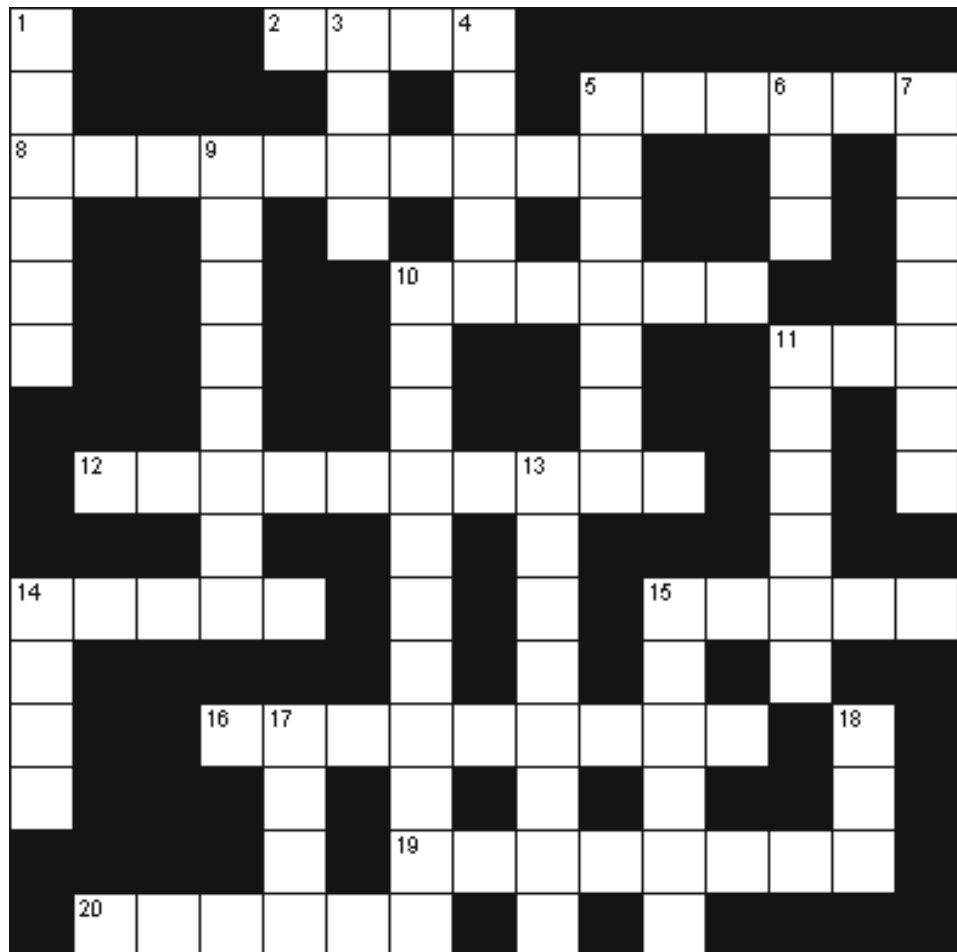
2. The last of the common eating utensil to be developed.
